Bayunga Arts Gallery is a gallery for artists, artisans and handcrafters

There is no commission on items sold. When an item sells the artist receives 100 per cent of the retail price!

- We have planned Bayunga Arts Gallery to be an interactive space between artists, artisans, handcrafters and the public. We want it to be fun, profitable for the exhibitor and a place where they can develop and promote their creative spirit and skills.
- **It's open to all artists and artisans and those involved in high level craftsmanship.**
- Our aim is to provide opportunity and support to artists for all but with a focus on those who are from the region.
- **Individuals or groups are both welcome to lease space.**
- We will occasionally hold short term individual or group exhibitions.
- **Bayunga Arts Gallery runs like a long-term market, giving artists and handcrafters the power over display and price and six days a week exposure to the public.**
- The Gallery is divided into variously sized spaces including wall, bench and free-standing space.
- **Space is available for as little as \$22 a week with the largest space, a wall space of 3mx3m costing \$60. Obtain a fees schedule for sizes and prices.**
- Students holding valid student cards are able to claim a reduction in fees. A separate fee schedule is available for students.
- **We provide customer service, including basic wrapping of articles**

where appropriate. If special wrapping or packaging is required, the artist is responsible for providing this material and instructions as to their requirements within reason.

- We will provide promotion and publicity through various channels including the internet, cinema advertising and the print media. For special events such as an exhibition, a regional event such as the Boorowa Woolfest, we will consider television advertising.
- **Bayunga staff will look after exhibits on a daily basis but exhibitors will be responsible for the setting up of their work, maintenance of the display and replacement of sold items.**
- Once an item is purchased, payment will be made immediately by direct deposit into the exhibitors bank account if the purchase is cash; if it is an electronic payment, we will transfer the funds as soon as they are cleared.
- **Due to our social ethics stance, we will encourage cash payments.**
- We have a commitment to social and environmental sustainability and will conduct the Gallery business accordingly.
- **Bayunga Arts Gallery is located in the main street of the historic pastoral town of Boorowa, near Canberra, close to a number of major highways.**
- **OPENING SPECIAL:** between our September opening date and the end of November, we are offering a short term contract with substantially reduced rates to interested artists and artisans.
- **Exhibitors will be required to sign contracts for three months, with an agreement for either weekly or monthly payments to be paid in advance.**
- A six month contract period at slightly lower weekly rates is also offered.
- **To ensure fairness to all and maintain a high standard, work proposed for exhibition will initially be reviewed by an independent committee.**
